

Hygiene and infection protection concept Euro Paint 2021

Strict compliance is the prerequisite for the show!

- ❖ The applicable official hygiene and infection control regulations of the Bavarian Infection Control Regulations must be observed: <https://www.stmgp.bayern.de/coronavirus/rechtsgrundlagen/>
- ❖ No spectators are allowed on the show ground
- ❖ **A maximum of two registered accompanying persons per participant is allowed, a replacement of accompanying persons during the show is not possible. Participants and accompanying persons must fill out a registration form (see last page) and hand it in on arrival. This form is used for contact person tracking and will be destroyed 4 weeks after the event.**
- ❖ Participants and accompanying persons will each receive a wristband, which must always be worn (on the wrist) on the show grounds. Persons without a wristband will be expelled from the show ground.
- ❖ Regular hand hygiene with soap and running water is necessary. Sufficient washing facilities with liquid soap and disposable towels are provided.
- ❖ Camping is allowed, but parking must be done in such a way that the minimum distance can be maintained.
- ❖ Participants are requested to park directly at the booked stable area to minimize distances.
- ❖ The registration office can only be reached personally on arrival. A mouth and nose cover must be worn in this area.
- ❖ All changes/new entries/requests for starting order etc. should be made by telephone, by Whatsapp or by e-mail (showoffice@euro-paint.info).

- ❖ Start and result lists will only be published digitally at www.horseshowtracker.com
- ❖ It is imperative that the specified box division is adhered to. In particular, empty boxes must be kept as such.
- ❖ The recommendation of the BRFV is to limit the number of horses to one horse per 100 square metres. The following maximum occupancy of the halls or places is derived from this:
 - Ostbayernhalle: max. 30 horses at a time
 - Event hall/training hall: max. 20 horses at a time
 - Stadium: max. 50 horses at the same time
 - Large outdoor arenas: max. 20 horses at a time, with the smaller outdoor arenas correspondingly fewer.
- ❖ A maximum of 100 persons (riders, accompanying persons, staff) are allowed to enter the riding halls at the same time. Spectators have no access.
- ❖ The PHCG e.V. also provides information about general and specific hygiene regulations through leaflets.

- ❖ Due to official regulations, the above-mentioned points are obligatory for the show participants and their accompanying persons. Violations of these obligations not only endanger the further participation in the show, but can put the entire show into question. Compliance with these regulations is not only monitored by us, but also by the authorities, especially the police. Violations will result in legal and police measures and exclusion from the show.
- ❖ Facilitations/relaxations will of course be passed on, as far as organizationally possible. If further restrictions are ordered by the authorities, these must be strictly implemented, even if they restrict the rights of the show participants and accompanying persons or even lead to a cancellation of the show.
- ❖ If the show cannot take place due to official decisions, the PHCG e.V. is not liable for damages - regardless of the legal basis. If the show is cancelled by official decision, the PHCG e.V. will attempt to refund entry fees already paid after deduction of all obligations entered into in connection with the show. The amount of the refund is at the discretion of the PHCG e.V. Board and is final.
- ❖ Should the show be cancelled due to official decisions, the above regulations regarding compensation and repayment of entry fees shall apply. If the show is cancelled due to the misconduct or non-compliance with the hygiene and safety regulations of individual participants or their accompanying persons, the PHCG e.V. reserves the right to take recourse to these participants or accompanying persons in the event of any damages or claims for compensation and to assert these damages through legal action.

The PHCG e.V. is neither entitled nor obliged to collect independent health data of the users. Therefore the tournament participant declares with signature on the contact form:

- ❖ To have read and understood the above rules and to release the organizer from any liability regarding a virus infection.
- ❖ That he/she and the accompanying persons do not enter the show grounds if
 - non-specific general symptoms and respiratory symptoms of any severity are present
 - An acute respiratory illness of any severity or fever
 - There's been contact with COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days.
- ❖ That he/she or the accompanying persons leave the tournament area immediately if he/she or the accompanying persons develop symptoms that are typical for Covid-19 (e.g. fever, respiratory problems)
- ❖ To respect the general rule of 1.5 m distance
- ❖ Ensure regular hand hygiene with soap and running water
- ❖ To wear a suitable mouth-nose cover in enclosed spaces (stables, indoor arenas, catering, registration office, sanitary facilities etc) and especially when passing through "narrow places" such as entrance areas, corridors etc
- ❖ Bring a sufficient number of mouth-nose-coverings, so that individual hygiene is possible throughout the entire duration of the show.
- ❖ To use all given possibilities of ventilation of the premises
- ❖ To leave the arena immediately after the end of the class
- ❖ To follow the instructions of the PHCG e.V. staff and representatives of the authorities at all times.

Note:

The house rules will be consistently used against persons who do not comply with the regulations.
